



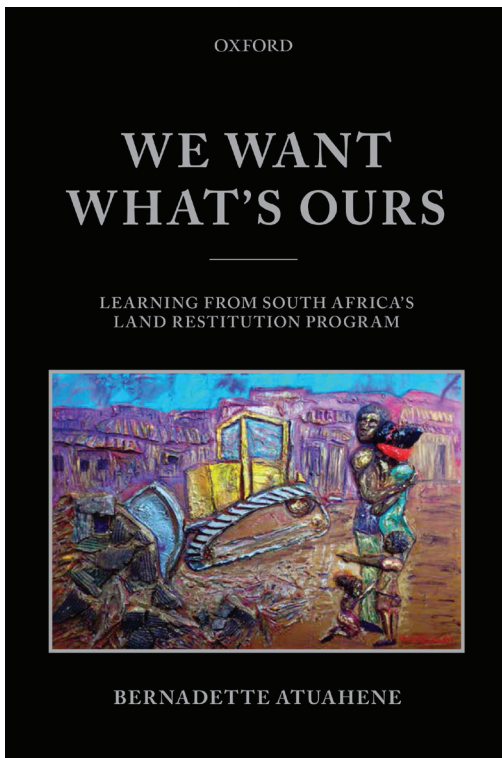
We Want What's Ours
